
# The .NET 5 Vision

# The Journey to One .NET

- .NET now looks back at a history lasting two decades...
- ...with many twists and turns
- .NET Framework, .NET Core, Mono, Xamarin, UWP, Silverlight, Windows Phone,...
- Different components, project structures, APIs,...
- .NET 5 is a huge step in the journey towards (re)unifying the .NET platform
- The goal is to get away from worrying about “what runs where” and simply “targeting .NET” with code that runs everywhere


# .NET – A unified platform



# The .NET 5 Platform

- .NET 5 represents a shared code base for .NET Core, Mono, Xamarin, and future .NET implementations
- Instead of targeting "netstandard", we now target "net5.0" (TFM = Target Framework)
- For platform specific projects, we will target things like "net5.0-windows"
  - In .NET 6, targets for things like "net6.0-ios" and "net6.0-android" will be added
- "net5.0" can be thought of as the next ".NET Standard" version

# .NET Timeline/Roadmap




- .NET 5 Release: November 10<sup>th</sup>, 2020
- Annual, predictable releases (started a year ago with .NET Core 3.1)
- Minor Releases if needed

# Visual Studio 2019 - Preview

- Minimum requirement is VS 2019 v16.8
- To use .NET 5, download the Visual Studio 2019 Preview version

# Desktop Development

# Windows Development

- WPF and Windows Forms supported as first-class citizens in .NET 5
- Improved Designer Support (both WinForms and XAML)
- Improved ClickOnce Support
- Single-file deployment

# Converting Full Framework Projects


- WinForms and WPF projects created on the full framework are not 100% compatible, but they are usually pretty close
- There now is a new conversion tool that attempts automatic conversion to .NET 5
  - <https://github.com/dotnet/try-convert/releases>
  - `dotnet tool install -g try-convert`

# Single File Applications

- .NET 5 aims to re-introduce the experience of publishing small, self-contained version of applications
  - Across all .NET application formats (Windows, Web,...)
  - Across all the platforms (Windows, Mac, Linux)
- Required Framework components are included in the deployment
- True xcopy-enabled, single-file executables
- Assembly Trimming
- .NET 5 has come a long way for this

# WinUI 3

- Continuation of WinRT, XAML Islands,...
- Windows 10 only
- Currently available as a preview



# Visual Basic Support

- Yes! You can now move your Visual Basic Desktop Apps to .NET 5!

# Desktop Development with VS Code

- You can use Visual Studio Code for desktop development
- As always, VS Code only edits code
- There is no designer support in VS Code
- Code editing performance still makes this a valuable additional option

# Web Development

# Blazor Updates in .NET 5

- Move to the new .NET 5 runtime (away from Mono)
- Significant Performance Improvements
  - Computational performance up to 30% faster
  - Component rendering 2-4x faster
- Virtualization support
  - Virtualize component rather than foreach-loops
- Prerendering for performance and search optimization
- CSS Isolation
- Lazy Loading of assemblies

- New tool: HttpRepl
- Project Tye


