




.NET Timeline



- .NET 8 Release: November 2023
 - DotNetConf – www.dotnetconf.net
- Azure services now support the new .NET 8 release
- Annual, predictable releases (started with .NET Core 3.1)
 - Minor Releases if needed




GA/Current vs. LTS



- Current versions (GA) are supported 15 months
 - (3 months after the next version's release date)
- LTS versions are supported for 3 years
- It should be easy to update from GA to LTS versions
- *Note: A lot of current tech targets .NET 6 as a minimum version*







- Rich **out-of-the-box** tooling
- Rich **overall** development experience




- **Editor-based** experience

C# Dev Kit

- Microsoft-built VS Code extension for C#
- Enables a richer development experience for C# developers in VS Code
- A great way for people to get into C# and .NET coding

C# Dev Kit: What's Included



C# 12

- Another gradual version increase of an already mature and sophisticated language
- Added features include things like:
 - Primary Constructors on classes
 - Collection Expressions
 - Default values for lambda parameters

GitHub Copilot

- Your code writing assistant
- Now has millions of users...
- ... and has become one of GitHub's most important offerings
- Promises great productivity gains...
 - ...which is undoubtedly true, but hard to measure
- I find it also provides great quality and capability improvements



- Blazor has turned into a full-stack web UI platform...
- ...that integrates into just about everything imaginable
- Render models have evolved very nicely
- It has become a compelling platform



Blazor – Full Stack Web UI



Full stack web UI

- Static server rendering
- Enhanced navigation & form handling
- Streaming rendering
- Add client interactivity per component or page
- Auto select the render mode at runtime




Blazor Render Models

- Cross Platform UI Development
- Windows, Mac, Android, iOS
- MAUI is the continuation of the Xamarin Forms technology
- “Multi-Platform App UI”
- Used internally at Microsoft for things like the M365 admin app and Azure admin app
- External customers, like NBC Sports






